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# Overview

- A two-year advocacy project (2011-2012)
- Underscores how Global Fund and US investments can be leveraged to increase access to quality integrated services

# Objectives

- 1) Increase priority of RH/HIV integration within the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, TB and Malaria and its supporting technical agencies in policy, program implementation, and funding allocation
- 2) Increase priority of RH/HIV integration within the President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR) and Global Health Initiative (GHI) policy, program implementation, and funding allocation decisions
- 3) Accelerate demand and promote civil society involvement and informed decision-making about RH/HIV and MNCH/ATM integration strategies

# Expected outcomes

- Increased country demand for reproductive health (RH)/HIV integration—including provision of RH supplies—and maternal, newborn and child health (MNCH)/AIDS, malaria and TB (ATM) integration.
- Increased priority and resources dedicated to RH/HIV integration and MNCH/ATM integration within influential global institutions
