

Coordination and Integration of HIV and Family Planning Services through Organizational Network Analysis (ONA)

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Goal and methods

- **Goal of baseline**
 - To use an ONA approach to understand how organizations work together to achieve program objectives, meet clients' needs, & reduce duplication or fill gaps.
- **Methods**
 - Snowball approach to identify all organizations providing FP or HIV services in 2 sub-cities of Addis Ababa
 - Organizational representative interviews (51 total)
 - Exchanges of information, resources, & clients (referrals)
 - Female home based care client interviews (459 total)



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Findings, next steps, & applications

- **Baseline findings**
 - Few referrals, of those to similar type organizations
 - Clients had needs for social services and to improve ART adherence
- **Conducted network strengthening activities**
 - Support for building network
- **Next steps: Follow-up**
 - Assess whether referrals improved & clients' perceptions
- **Potential applications of ONA**
 - Program assessment: to i.d. and improve referral gaps
 - Evaluation: to assess quantitatively changes in referrals over time



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
