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R-MARS Pilot: Introduction and Process

MAIN OBJECTIVE OF THE PILOT:

Assess the feasibility, utility, and validity of the R-MARS Toolkit in diverse settings.

TOOLKIT COMPONENTS:

C1: Initial assessment of referral system and its monitoring

C2: R-MARS referral monitoring indicator reference sheets

C3: R-MARS generic tools for collecting, analyzing, and reporting referral system monitoring data

C4: Decision guide for managers based on referral system monitoring information

Methods:

- Site selection
- Stakeholder identification and engagement
- Training on the R-MARS toolkit
- Referral system initial assessment: qualitative
- Adjustments to data collection and analysis tools
- Data collection and reporting on R-MARS indicators: quantitative
- R-MARS Evaluation: key informant interviews: qualitative
- Final R-MARS pilot report development
